

EXTERIOR FRONT VIEW This is the view from the driveway as you enter from Bethel Road. The phase 1 structure will be a total of 16,000 square feet (an 8,000 square foot upper level and an 8,000 square foot lower level). The two levels will have a staircase and elevator.



INTERIOR FLOOR PLAN This space will provide restrooms, a lobby, and a worship auditorium, which can be used for many different purposes throughout the week. In phase 1, the auditorium will provide approximately 338 seats, which will allow us to comfortably facilitate over 650 individuals by hosting 2 gatherings, and over 1,000 individuals with the possibility of 3 gatherings.



INTERIOR FLOOR PLAN This space will provide additional restrooms and kid's environments, and will feature electronic check-in and secure classrooms. The "Future Expansion" portion of the lower level will be left to finish at a later date.

how can i get involved?

why do we need more commitments?

- Real Home gives everyone at ValleyPoint the opportunity to be part of something that will outlast us! We want you to have the opportunity to be part of something special and significant.
- Additional commitments will help with infrastructure costs on our property, improvements to design, and the opportunity to fully finish areas needed for children's ministry.
- Your participation will allow you to take a step of faith alongside many others who have already committed to Real Home.

Real Home FAQs

Why take this risk?

- To reach more people for Christ. We can reach more people using our own campus as a tool to do so. As a general rule, churches that build...GROW. Think of what we could offer the community in the name of Christ if we had a 7-day-a-week facility.
- To send the community a message. That message is, "We're here to stay." This gives us an opportunity to establish a lasting footprint in this area.
- To re-direct some of our ministry energy. Sunday is extremely labor-intensive while we're portable. What if we were able to redirect some of that ministry energy into the community?
- To establish a place for generations to call "home."

How big will the new facility be?

We're currently looking at a phase one structure that will be two stories of 8,000 square feet each (16,000 square feet total). Phase one will provide approximately 338 seats in the auditorium as well as 190 parking places.

How much will the building cost?

The total cost will be \$4.2 million. We have raised 3-year commitments of \$1.7 million and we would like to add to that amount to cover expected additional infrastructure costs.

What is expected in making a financial commitment?

As a faith community, we should all pray about what we believe God would want to do through us to accomplish His redemptive work in this area. Every person (family) is being asked to pray about his or her financial commitment. No one will be pressured, and nothing will be published.

May I give assets (property, stocks, bonds) other than cash?

Yes. One of the members of our Finance Team will be happy to discuss this with you.
